

At a meeting held in F
Henderson's restaurant on the
evening of June 25 1914. The
Scherrville Volunteer Fire
Company was organized.
With Fred Henderson who
was previously appointed
Fire Chief for the town by the
Scherrville town board presid-
ing.

The rules and bylaws were
read and accepted by
all members present, and
the following officers elected.

All members were appointed
temporary places to fill
during practice till they
will be appointed regular
positions, & certain duties
to perform later.

It was decided to obtain
the use of the town hall
for regular meetings of the
company if possible, and
the first regular meeting
set for July 2nd 1914.

All other meetings following
on the first & third ~~Friday~~ ^{Thursday}
of each month.

It was decided, however
until the company had had
sufficient practice to understand
the manipulation of the apparatus,
there should be one or two
special meetings each week.
It was also decided to recommend
to the Scherrville town board
at its next regular meeting
that there be a large quantity
of fire extinguisher purchased
that the ladders & other
equipment be finished soon
as it is now in a ~~bad~~ ^{very}
rough condition.

"and that you sort of a cart
or wagon be furnished on
which to carry ladders.

"and that the standard code
of signals be printed &
distributed through town.
A special assessment of 25¢
was collected from each
member by consent of all
present.
