



DAV Walk proceeds to help local military veterans

On Saturday, August 24, U.S. Military veterans who suffered disabilities while actively serving our Country will be honored at the St. John Township Walk for the Disabled American Veterans co-hosted by DAV Chapter #17/Hammond, IN; the Town of Schererville and the St. John Township Trustee Cathy J. Lareau.

Adults and children from throughout the area are invited to participate by pre-registering at www.DAV17IN.com or by registering the day of the walk between 8:30 and 10 a.m. at the Schererville Town Court, 25 East Joliet St., next to the Veterans Memorial. The registration fee is \$25 for adults and \$10 for students and includes a Tshirt, water and lunch served by The Sizzle Shack.

The opening ceremony begins at 10 a.m. at the Veterans Memorial. Participants will then move to the 9/11 Memorial located in front of the Schererville Police Department where the DAV Walk steps off following the ceremony. Attendees can walk south one-quarter mile along the Pennsy Greenway Trail directly to Redar Park at 217 Gregory St. Those who are physically impaired can drive to Redar Park.

"Attendees will be able to walk around Redar Park if they desire. Lunch will be served at Redar Park by The Sizzle Shack," said St. John Township Trustee Cathy J. Lareau.

There will also be the following:

- A display of more than 300 placards representing the fallen heroes from the State who have died since 9/11 displayed in the Police Department parking lot by the Indiana Fallen Heroes Foundation
- · A display from the Tri-Town Safety Village Veterans Museum based in Schererville
- A display by the 1441 Foundation to raise suicide awareness for fellow veterans and their families

- Patriotic music provided by Joe Cantafio, and
- · American Legion Post 485 will be accepting worn and torn old flags.

All the proceeds from the walk will be used by the DAV organization to help local veterans. The DAV organization is a non-profit organization formed in 1919 and incorporated in 1945 by military veterans who suffered some degree of disability while actively serving our country. The DAV is a non-partisan organization, with no political affiliation that neither endorses nor opposes candidates for political office. The DAV receives no Federal funds. Dues and contributions fund the organization.

The services the DAV offers to local veterans including the following:

- Providing free, professional assistance to veterans and their families in obtaining benefits and services earned through military service and provided by the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) and other agencies of government.
- · Providing outreach concerning its program services to the American people generally, and to disabled veterans and their families specifically.
- · Representing the interests of disabled veterans, their families, their widowed spouses and their orphans before Congress, the White House and Judicial Branch, as well as state and local governments.
- Extending DAV's mission of hope into the communities where these veterans and their families live through a network of state-level Departments and local chapters.
- Providing a structure through which disabled veterans can express their compassion for their fellow veterans through a variety of volunteer
- Needy causes that touch the lives of our Veterans as needed.


