Mr. Rettig, Engineer, representing Mr. Delco for the project stated they would like to build office warehouse buildings on that property. He stated that there is a lot of flood plains in those 9-10 acres but they would like to use the frontage along Junction for nice buildings, two driveways, one driveway for two buildings, two different locations.

Mr. Gorman stated that this petitioner was in front of the BZA last year, they approved it and they came before the Town Council, which the Council approved, but because of COVID and certain conditions that the petitioners had to go through they paused it. Mr. Gorman stated that they came before the BZA last month and presented it. He stated that nothing has changed, the building is next to Walmart, which is the old Payless Shoes.

Mr. Schmitt made a motion to approve BZA Case #21-6-10 and to include the records that were sent to the Council by the BZA, including the Findings of Fact and the certification, seconded by Mr. Johnson. Roll call vote: Mr. Johnson - Yes; Mr. Connelly - Yes; Mr. Schmitt - Yes; Mrs. Arvanitis - No; Mr. Guetzloff - Yes. Motion carries (4-1).

ITEM E. Award Bid for Community Crossing Grant 2021-1

Mr. Simstad stated that they have the recommendation for the award of the 2021-1 Community Crossing Matching Grant Award from INDOT. He stated that they opened bids yesterday, July $13^{\rm th}$, he

stated there were four bids on this project. Mr. Simstad stated that the submitted cost on the application was \$825,366.21. He stated that the four bids arrange from \$783,307.08 to \$967,715.27. He stated that all bidders did submit the required bid security. Mr. Simstad stated that the recommendation based on the lowest most responsive and responsible bidder is to Milestone Contractors North in the amount of \$783,307.08.

Mr. Schmitt asked Mr. Hansen to explain the money we were awarded. Mr. Hansen stated that we were awarded \$412,000.00, he stated that we won't receive all of that because the bid came in under. He stated that the Town will pay one half of the \$783,207.08.

Mr. Schmitt made a motion to award the bid to Milestone Construction North for \$783,307.08, seconded by Mr. Connelly.

Mr. Johnson asked Mr. Simstad if Milestone Contractors North is a contractor we have dealt with in the past. Mr. Simstad stated yes, he has been working with them since 1995 and the Town has been dealing with them long before that.

All in favor (5-0).

ITEM F. Illiana Speedway Property

Mr. Johnson made a motion to approve the staff to move forward with the Lake Council Economic Alliance to prepare for publication and distribution of an RFP for the Illiana Speedway Business Park project that has been authorized, seconded by Mr. Connelly. All in favor (5-0).

ITEM G. Consider acceptance of Donations for \$35,582.36

Mr. Troxell stated most of these donations are for National Night Out. He stated that there are over 100 donations. Mr. Troxell asked that those donations be added to the minutes.

Mr. Connelly made a motion to accept the donations, seconded by Mrs. Arvanitis. All in favor (5-0).
